

## Ceiling Fan Cleaning Checklist

<b>1. Preparation</b>	
<b>Tools:</b>	
<b>Safety Gear:</b> Gloves, goggles, and a face mask to protect against dust and cleaning agents.	
<b>Drop Cloth:</b> Place a drop cloth, old sheet, or newspapers beneath the fan to catch falling dust and debris.	
<b>Ladder or Step Stool:</b> Ensure it is stable and at the right height for reaching the fan comfortably.	
<b>2. Turn Off Power</b>	
<b>Ensure Safety:</b>	
<b>Turn Off the Fan and Light:</b> Make sure the ceiling fan and any attached light fixtures are switched off. For added safety, turn off the power at the circuit breaker.	
<b>Verify:</b> Double-check that the fan blades are not moving before proceeding.	
<b>3. Remove Light Globes</b>	
<b>Clean Light Fixtures Separately:</b>	
<b>Detach Light Globes:</b> Carefully remove the light globes or shades.	
<b>Wash and Dry:</b> Clean them in a sink with warm soapy water, rinse, and let them dry completely before reattaching.	
<b>4. Dusting</b>	
<b>Remove Loose Dust:</b>	
<b>Tools:</b> Use a long-handled duster, U-shaped brush, or an old pillowcase.	
<b>Technique:</b> For a contained method, slip an old pillowcase over each blade and pull it back, trapping dust inside the pillowcase. Alternatively, use a long-handled duster to remove dust from each blade.	
<b>5. Cleaning Blades</b>	
<b>Thorough Cleaning:</b>	
<b>Mild Cleaning Solutions:</b> Prepare a solution of water and mild dish soap or a mixture of water and white vinegar (1:1 ratio).	
<b>Gentle Pressure:</b> Moisten a microfiber cloth or sponge with the cleaning solution (avoid spraying directly onto the fan) and gently wipe each blade. Be careful not to bend or damage the blades.	
<b>Motor Housing:</b> Don't forget to clean the motor housing with a damp cloth or use a vacuum with a soft brush attachment to remove dust from the vents.	
<b>6. Drying and Reassembling</b>	
<b>Prevent Dust Attraction:</b>	
<b>Thorough Drying:</b> Use a dry microfiber cloth to wipe each blade and component thoroughly to prevent moisture-related issues.	
<b>Reattach Light Globes:</b> Once completely dry, reattach the light globes or shades securely.	
<b>7. Final Checks</b>	
<b>Ensure Proper Functionality:</b>	
<b>Test Fan Operation:</b> Turn the power back on and set the fan to a low speed to ensure it's operating smoothly. Listen for any unusual noises that may indicate loose components.
